Job Summary:

Under general supervision, the Maintenance Worker I performs a variety of tasks within the Public Works Department. Tasks include assisting with maintenance and repairs of streets and water system.

Essential Job Functions:

Assists in reading meters, general installation, maintenance and repair of water system mains and water pipes.

Assists in street, drainage and alley maintenance.

Operates motorized equipment used in street and alley maintenance.

May occasionally be required to work on-call, evenings or weekends.

Maintains safety regulations including wearing appropriate clothing, erecting proper barricades and signage and using proper equipment and tools.

Performs other related duties as assigned.
